Neighborhood watch apps like Nextdoor and Citizen are far from neighborly, providing volunteer labor to police in expanding their surveillance capabilities.






Profiling and stereotyping are a feature, not a bug, for neighborhood surveillance apps. We can't let these broken, biased tools become the norm.
